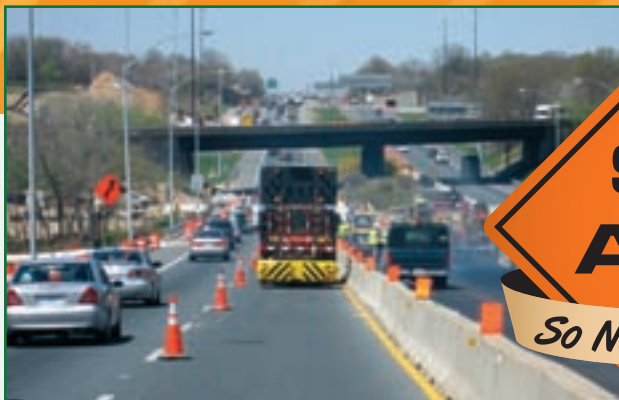

What you should know about construction efforts, congestion relief and work zone safety

HOW WILL IT AFFECT YOU?

As a result of the construction work scheduled in the coming months, you may experience some noise and notice added dust in your neighborhood caused by the following activities and operating equipment:

- Pavement breaking
- Paving/resurfacing
- Bridge deck removal
- Back-up alarms
- Milling/grinding machines
- Crane equipment
- Forklifts
- Night work
- Generators/compressors
- Backhoes
- Pile driving
- Earthmovers
- Bulldozers



So No One Gets Hurt!

All four lanes of I-95 will be open in each direction during peak travel periods. Periodic lane closures on I-95 and detours will occur.

ETLsSM are coming soon!

In July 2005, the Maryland Transportation Authority (MdTA) received federal approval to construct Express Toll LanesSM (ETLs)SM on the most congested portion of I-95 north of Baltimore City. This 10-mile segment stretches from the I-895 split in N.E. Baltimore, to north of MD 43 (White Marsh Boulevard).

What are ETLs?

ETLs are new travel lanes that give motorists the option of paying a fee to drive in separate, less-congested highway lanes. Widening of I-95 will result in two ETLs and four general-purpose (free) lanes in each direction.

But that's not all – more improvements to come with the ETLs project.

New bridge overpasses and interchange improvements at I-895, I-695 and MD 43 are also part of this congestion-relief project. Completion is on schedule for 2011. Periodic detours and closures will occur.

CONSTRUCTION IS RAMPING UP

on I-95 Express Toll LanesSM (ETLSM) between Rossville and Campbell Boulevards

I-95 will be widened to six lanes in each direction between Rossville Boulevard and Campbell Boulevard. This phase of construction will extend approximately two miles along I-95 and will join ongoing construction at the I-95/I-695 interchange. This mainline I-95 construction has just begun and is scheduled for completion in October 2009.
