# I-95 Express Toll Lanes<sup>SM</sup>

*TRANSITION PROJECT – I-95 Southbound Improvements between I-895 and Eastern Avenue*

## *I-95 Southbound between I-895 and Eastern Avenue (Exit 59)*

In conjunction with the I-95 Express Toll Lanes (ETLs<sup>SM</sup>) project, the Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) has begun construction to convert the current three lane roadway configuration to four lanes for approximately 1.5 miles along I-95 from the southern end of the I-95 ETLs project to north of the Eastern Avenue interchange (Exit 59). The purpose of this work is to add a fourth southbound lane to facilitate the merging of ETL and general purpose traffic. During construction, motorists should expect reduced shoulders and lane shifts.

### **About Construction**

Construction began in August 2010 and is expected to be completed in early 2012. Work includes, but is not limited to:

- Pavement Milling and Resurfacing.
- Full-Depth Pavement Reconstruction.
- Concrete Barrier Replacement.
- Bridge Deck Demolition and Construction.
- Bridge Parapet Wall Demolition and Construction.
- Storm Drain Improvements.
- New Stormwater Management Facility.
- Landscaping.
- Signing and Marking.
- Lighting.
